School Description:

Located in beautiful, Upstate New York, Syracuse University College of Law is on the main campus of Syracuse University – a top-tier private research institution with a student population of 22,000+ and an international student population of 4,000+.



The [College of Law](#) enrolls approximately 650 students in its J.D. and LL.M. programs each year. It is home to the Technology Commercialization Law Center - combining intellectual property with business law principles to bring new technology from the laboratory to the marketplace -, the world-renowned Institute for National Security and Counterterrorism, and the Disability Law and Policy Center.

The [Master of Laws \(LL.M.\) in American Law](#) program can be completed in one academic year over two semesters. In this program, students gain exposure to the foundations of the American legal system while being able to specialize their studies in a variety of subjects such as technology commercialization an intellectual property, international human rights, national security and counterterrorism, private corporate/commercial law, and international and comparative disability law and policy. Students have the opportunity to pursue a variety of professional development programs such as our Job Shadow Program and our International Scholar Lecture Series. The College of Law's Office of International Programs provides significant academic and peer support. Students may become eligible to sit for the New York Bar Exam.
